

Appendix 3 – Cutting and drying pasture quadrants for estimating pasture availability

- 1. Make a 25 cm square quadrant out of timber, weldmesh or other suitable material.
- 2. Place the quadrant on a representative section of pasture.
- 3. Cut the pasture in the quadrant close to the ground and avoid collecting dirt.
- 4. Weigh the pasture sample using kitchen scales (e.g. 500 g).





Divide into quarters and start again

Sub-sampling to get a sample size small enough top dry.
