**Fig. 3.—**Dorsal, ventral, and lateral views of crania of *Hylomyscus*: A) *H. kerbispeterhansi*, new species (FMNH 210017 [holotype]; ONL = 26.7 mm), a female from Mau Escarpment, Kenya; B) *H. anselli* (FMNH 171362; ONL =

27.6 mm), a female from Mbizi Mountains, Tanzania; and C) *H. arcimontensis* (FMNH 150139; ONL = 24.9 mm), a male from East Usambara Mountains, Tanzania.

**Fig. 5.**—Scatter plot of canonical variates (CV) axes 1 and 2 depicting results of discriminant function analysis performed on 14 log-transformed craniodental measurements. Projection of individual scores from 165 specimens assigned to 4 *Hylomyscus* taxa are depicted by the following symbols:  $\circ = kerbispeterhansi$ , + = anselli,  $\square = arcimontensis$ ,  $\diamond = endorobae$ . Ellipses indicate 95% confidence limits for taxa.
